SHOW RULES AND QUALIFICATIONS

Any abusive language or behaviour towards show officials animals or fellow competitors will result in expulsion from the showground and by entering this show you agree to abide by the following

1. No refunds or cancellation of entry fees are permitted.
2. This show is not open to the public and is run in accordance with the Baston South Lincolnshire Show Health & Safety and Child & Vulnerable Person Policies; anyone at the request of any member of the show committee not complying in respect of these policies will be removed from the Showground.
3. In order to comply with the Baston South Lincolnshire Show Health & Safety Policy, dogs should be kept on a lead at all times and are the responsibility of their owner.
4. All horses and ponies must be attended to at all times whilst outside of the lorry or trailer; this is a requirement of the show Health & Safety policy.
5. You are strongly advised that any pony/horse attending this show should be insured at least third party; failure to comply cannot become the liability of the show organisers and committee.

NPS QUALIFYING ROUNDS: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part breeds are not eligible for Mountain & Moorland Classes. To compete in Show Pony and Show Hunter Pony classes ponies must be registered in the NPS British Riding Pony Stud Book, Register, Appendix, International or Sports Pony section of the BRPSB, the GSB, the AHSB, the AASB or in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part-Breeds are not eligible unless entered in the NPS British Riding Pony Stud Book, Register, Appendix, International or Sports Pony section of the BRPSB.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS **Qualifying or Life** members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from **6th – 8th August 2019**

The highest placed pony, if owned by an NPS member, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified.

NPS/Rosettes Direct Home-Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home-Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show. The Owner's Membership cards **MUST** be produced in the ring when requested or the qualification will be forfeit.

THE NPS/PICTON STUD M&M NOVICE RIDDEN NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP: Open to pure bred registered M&M stallions, mares and geldings four years old or over.

A pony is not eligible to compete if, before 1st January in the current year, it has done any of the following:

- i. Won an open NPS affiliated mixed M&M Ridden class
- ii. Qualified for Horse of the Year Show, Olympia or RIHS Open M&M Ridden classes
- iii. Qualified for the M&M Novice or Intermediate Ridden final at the NPS Summer Championship show (N.B. Ponies can compete as novices in this competition for two consecutive years provided, they do not submit an entry to the final in the first year).
- iv. If a pony qualifies for Horse of the Year Show, Olympia or RIHS in its second year it is immediately de-noviced and cannot compete in the Picton Final. Ponies must be shown in a snaffle bit.

THE NPS/RINGSIDE STUD M&M OPEN RIDDEN NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP: Open to registered pure bred M&M stallions, mares and geldings four years old or over.

NPS SILVER MEDAL ROSETTE CHAMPIONSHIPS: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the owner of the champion pony is a **Qualifying or Life** member of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the rider's/handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the owner of the Champion pony is not a member, or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette, but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships.

Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the final of the Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show **6th – 8th August 2019**.

EQUIFEST: This Show is affiliated to Equifest, taking place at the East of England Showground on the 29th Aug to 1st Sept 2019. The two highest exhibits not already qualified in classes 2, 10, 31, 32 & 33 affiliated classes will qualify.

ROYAL INTERNATIONAL HORSE SHOW: At BSPS Affiliated Shows that are qualifiers for the RIHS the highest placed pony, not already qualified, from the first three ponies will qualify. Owners and riders must be BSPS Members before the date of the show to qualify in classes with qualification for R.I.H.S., (including Heritage qualifying classes), and animals must be registered with the BSPS except for the Anglo and Part Bred Arabs who must be registered with the AHS and registration numbers declared when entering. Membership forms and payment must be received in the office no later than the last working day (Monday to Friday) prior to the date of the qualifying show. (See Rule 22).

NB. The RIHS qualification is subject to confirmation from BSPS Head Office

BSPS CHAMPIONSHIPS: Ponies qualify as follows: 1st & 2nd prize winners in classes: - Open Lead Rein Class 32 Open First Ridden Class 33, Open Nursery Stakes Class 3, Open WHP 133cms, 143cms, 153 Classes 4, 5, 6. Open SHP 122cms, 133cms, 143cms & 153cms Classes 36, 37, 38, 39.

1st, 2nd & 3rd prize winners in the following classes: -, Open Intermediate SH Class 25 and Open Intermediate SRT Classes 26 & 27. Int WHP class 7.

Mixed Height Classes - 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th placed ponies will qualify, Open WHP Class 2, Mixed Height Novice SP Class 30, Mixed Height Open SP Class 31 & Mixed height Novice SHP Class 34.

BSPS 'BLACK COUNTRY SADDLES' BEST RIDER: This show is a qualifier for the B.S.P.S Best Rider of the Year. The Best rider in the Open Lead rein, Open First Ridden, 128cms. 138cms. and 148cms. Show Ponies, Open lead rein Hunter Type, the 122cms. 133cms. 143cms and 153cms. SHP. The Cradle and Nursery stakes, the 133cms. 143cms.and 153cms WHP, Open Intermediate Show Riding Type, Show Hunter and Working Hunter classes. Open Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden and to the best rider 25years and under in the Heritage Ridden and WHP classes will receive a Card and qualify for the final at the BSPS Summer Championships Show

BSPS CLASSIC SECURITY UK LTD CHALLENGE: All Summer Qualifying Shows affiliated to the BSPS are qualifiers for The BSPS Challenge. Animals may qualify for the BSPS Challenge. Ponies must not have qualified for the HOYs 2018. Animals must have qualified for the challenge by attending any BSPS affiliated shows and competed in the appropriate class

Open Lead Rein and First Ridden, Open show ponies, Nursery stakes, Open Lead Rein of Hunter Type, Open Show Hunter Pony, Open Working Hunter Pony, the Open Intermediate SRT., SH and WH. and the Heritage Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden and WHP classes.

If the highest placed pony has already qualified for the BSPS Challenge, the qualification will be awarded to the next eligible pony.

THE BSPS BINKS FAMILY 50th YEAR GOLDEN ANNIVERSARY SHOW CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS:

The Rider/Handler qualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of Finals!

TSR Riders Finals - 1st & 2nd riders qualify and will receive a qualification card in the ring.

TSR MEDAL AWARDS: TSR members can collect qualification cards & signatures and redeem for a TSR Medal see TSR website for details.

BSHA Grass Roots Champs: With a TSR qualification card you can also enter the BSHA Grass Roots Championship in Sept at Addington Equestrian Centre - You do not have to be a BSHA member to qualify or enter the final. See www.britishshowhorse.org
